Each of these themes is addressed in a separate section.

Each section is structured in a similar way:-

- o Firstly, an outline of the issues associated with the theme
- Secondly, the inclusion of a number of examples of good practice
- o Thirdly, a set of recommendations, in many cases separated out to:-
 - EU institutions
 - Member states
 - NGOs / Civic Society organisations

Process

This report has drawn from a variety of sources:-
